
Dear Parent/Carer,

You will be aware that Haverstock was inspected by Ofsted on 24<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> of January this year. The report has just been published and is available on the website. Overall the school was judged against the new Ofsted framework as a school that 'Requires Improvement.'

Given the huge improvements that Haverstock has made over the past ten years it is disappointing to be judged 'Requires Improvement.' The report acknowledges many strengths, as well as areas that we are working hard to improve and judges that the leadership of the school knows itself well and has the capacity to bring about the changes that it has identified to continue to develop the school.

As a school we have experienced a succession of changes over the past two years and have put in place new personnel, structures and processes that we are confident will quickly re-establish our position as a 'good' school within the Camden family. The report commented positively on the new structures that have been put in place, but that as yet there was insufficient time elapsed to demonstrate their impact. We have a robust plan that we have developed with the support of Camden Local Authority, which will be monitored carefully by the leadership and governors of the school, as well as Camden Officers.
